Online Summer Intensive FAQs

How long will the Online Summer Intensive last?

The live classes will start on 22nd August 2020 and end on 23rd August 2020.

Will I have to audition for the course?

No, there is no selection procedure.

Do I need to send any photographs or videos?

No, you will not need to send any photographs or videos.

I have never danced before, is the course suitable for me?

Please note that the classes are not for beginner students or for students who have limited experience.

Students should be studying a syllabus delivered by a recognised classical dance awarding body, or if attending full time vocational training, the method of training provided at their school.

My child is slightly younger than 8 but is very talented, can they take part in a Junior class?

The course is not designed for students below the age of 8. If you are unsure which level you are at then we recommend that you ask your regular teacher for advice before you register for any class.

How can I decide which level I should choose?

We recommend that you ask your teacher, as they would know what is best for you. Please read the level descriptors.

What should I wear?

For all ballet classes, we recommend that you wear leotard and tights, soft ballet shoes and hair neatly tied back for the girls/women. Boys/men should wear leotard/t-shirt, shorts/tights, soft ballet shoes, with long hair tied back. Have your trainers with you to wear for allegro if preferred.

Please ensure that you are practicing these classes in a safe environment and have the correct equipment and footwear. The School will not accept any responsibility for injuries that occur while undertaking any exercises or classes in the home environment or dance studio.

Technical requirements

Are there any geographical restrictions?

No, students from all countries can join in the course. Classes and talks will be live streamed between 9am and 6:30pm, BST.

What are the technical requirements for an optimal experience?

We recommend that you use a computer or a laptop to join the class. A good wifi connection is also recommended. Please note that no refund will be provided if your connection does not enable you to follow the class properly.

How do I access the classes?

You will receive an email with the list of classes that you have chosen, together with a link to access the workshop.

How do I open my link to a class?

You can either click on the link in your email, or copy and paste it into your browser.
