

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I know if my payment has been received?

We are working towards using a system that is able to offer automatic receipts, however in the meantime we will contact those with outstanding payments due. What are the dates for the payment plan?

Other than the Fees, are there any additional costs?

There will be a selection of NYB merchandise available to buy in advance.

We will also operate a Tuck Shop selling sweets, snacks and treats during the residential - please bring a small amount of cash if you would like to buy anything from this shop.

Dancers will need to provide their own dance shoes and tights for the residential and performances depending on what the choreographer wants them to wear.

My child is concerned about staying away from home. Can they attend as a day student?

We really understand that staying away from home can be a big step for our young people. We have a dedicated Safeguarding and Support Team Manager, Nisha Denton, as well as house parents who are there to look after the wellbeing of the children. There is a great deal of learning and personal development that takes place in the out of hours part of the course, so if possible, we would encourage all of our dancers to stay. For some, we understand that this would really compromise their experience, and we have allowed people to attend as day students in the past. Unfortunately we would be unable to offer any reduction in the fees if your child was not resident on the programme. What are the dates for which accommodation is provided?

The residential component of the RPC starts from arrival on Sunday 13th August 2023 and participants will be free after their second performance on Saturday 19th August 2023.

All food and accommodation is included in the price as part of the residential

Can parents visit during the residential?

There is no capacity for children to go home during the residential, however some parents do come to see the Choreographic Competition which will be held on Thursday 17th August 2023.

What happens during the day?

The students will do company class and a Moving Minds session in the morning followed by rehearsals for the shows all day.

What happens in the evenings?

The students have activities in the evenings, including a Choreographic Competition and a party. Other activities could include films, industry professional talks and games nights.
