Welcome

It is a pleasure to welcome you to this sharing of National Youth Ballet's All In! project, in collaboration with Parable Dance and South East Dance.

Dancers from NYB and Parable Dance have joined forces to create an inclusive ballet company. You will see them perform their own adaptation of *Romeo and Juliet*, choreographed by NYB Beyond Ballet® choreographers Ross Black and Hannah George.

This sharing is the culmination of four days in the rehearsal studio this August, but All In! is underpinned by a longer period of research and development, and continued professional development, delivered by Parable Dance Artistic Director Natasha Britton and NYB Creative Director Jo Meredith earlier in the year. In December 2022 we piloted our first R&D workshops with choreographers and South East-based local ballet teachers to explore inclusive practice with expert practitioners with lived experience of disability to explore how ballet could be taught and choreographed in a more inclusive way. In April 2023 we tested our model in a creative workshop led by Beyond Ballet® choreographers, Ross Black and Hannah George with NYB and Parable dancers to apply our learning about inclusive practice and explore inclusive skills development for dancers.

These choreographers have further developed their skills and led this inclusive group of young dancers under the guidance of NYB ambassador Joe Powell-Main. NYB Beyond Ballet® Lighting Designer Ros Chase and Costume Supervisor Elisa Mozzanica have supported the creation of this work, alongside a dedicated group of assistants and volunteers.

NYB is passionate about finding ways to make ballet more accessible and inclusive. All In! is an important part of this vision, for audiences, for participants and sector development. We hope to take the learning from this activity into all of our other work.

We are extremely grateful to our volunteers, to the team at South East Dance and all the funders and individual supporters who have made this work possible.
