### **Nut-Free Zone**

Do not bring food containing nuts.

Some participants have **serious allergies**.

Please **do not share food**.

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### **Stay on Campus**

Participants **must not leave the campus** during the residential.

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### **Out of Bounds**

Do not enter areas marked **Out of Bounds**.

Do not use **Emergency Exit doors unless there is a real emergency**.

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### **Respect the Space**

Help keep the residential clean.

- Keep bedrooms tidy
  - Use bins and recycling
  - Do not damage property
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### **Respect Personal Boundaries**

Be respectful of personal space.
